SUB-Q SUBCUTANEOUS INJECTION

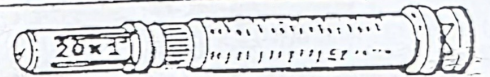
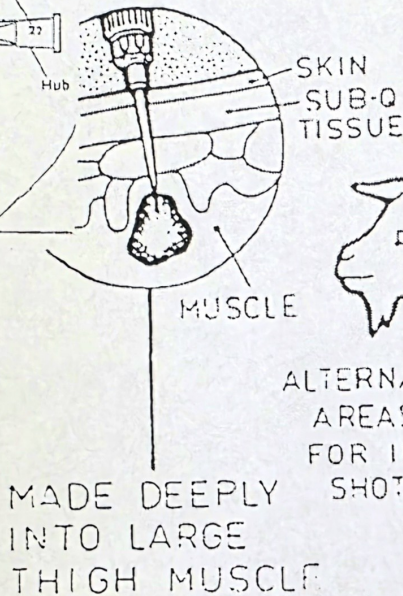


CLEAN SMALL AREA WITH ALCOHOL - PICK UP SKIN - INSERT NEEDLE - DISCHARGE DOSAGE

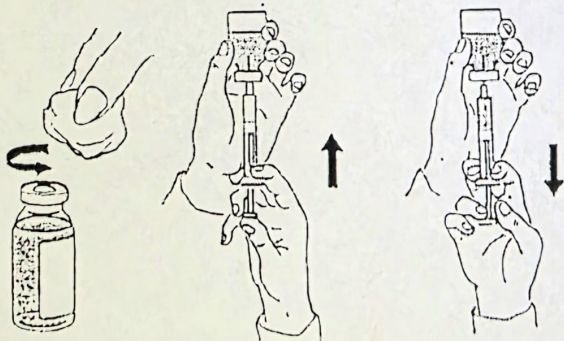
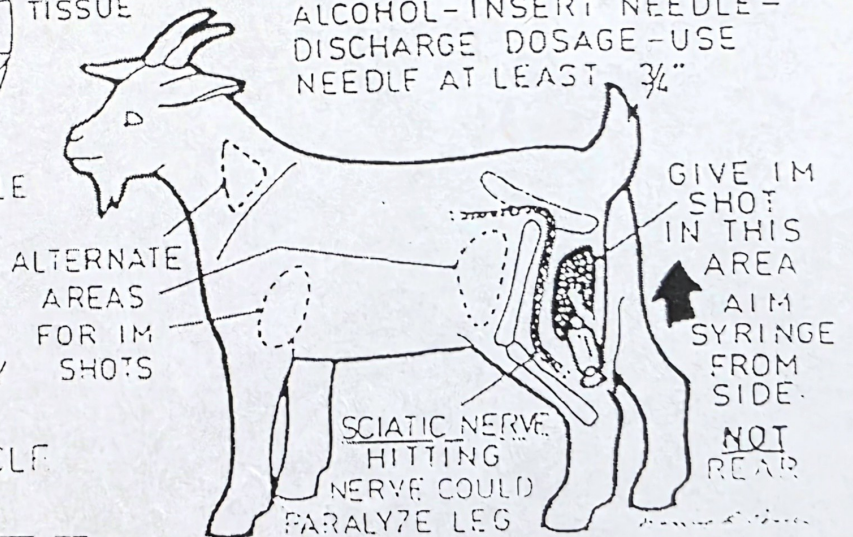
MASSAGE AREA AFTER SHOT

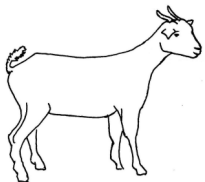
